

Saudi Arabia



The (0) of Saudi Arabia lies on the Arabian Peninsula in Southwest Asia. It is one of the driest countries on earth and the (25) of its landscape (95%) is desert. Saudi Arabia is a Muslim country with a (26) of about 27 million, roughly 20% of which are resident (27) (or 'expats'). It is home to two of Islam's holiest cities: Mecca and Medina, where every year, an estimated two million Muslims make a pilgrimage. Saudi Arabia is the world's largest (28) and (29) of oil. Huge oil reserves were discovered near the capital, Rivadh, in 1937, and oil now provides (30) 90% of the country's income. Because Saudi Arabia has no lakes or rivers and very low and (31) rainfall, it has invested (32) in seawater desalination technology. It is now the world's largest (33) of desalinated water. Over one billion m³ of fresh water are produced each year from seawater, providing about 70% of the Kingdom's (34) needs.
