



Crossroads of Europe, Asia and America The Suez Canal is a 192 km artificial waterway (0) connects the Mediterranean Sea with the Red Sea. It provides a shortcut for ships travelling between European and American ports, as well as ports located (13) Asia, Africa and Oceania.
