

191. Sony, the Japanese electronics giant<sup>A</sup> is to establish a non-life insurance<sup>B</sup> operation focusing initially on selling discounted cars insurance policies<sup>C</sup> the company said yesterday.
192. The review of Mitsubishi, Mitsui and Sumitomo brings to five a number of<sup>A</sup> Japanese trading houses on watch for credit problems<sup>B</sup>, and highlights the impact of the Asian financial crisis on Japanese companies.
193. The personal department<sup>A</sup> is a department within a firm<sup>B</sup> that is responsible for relations between the employer and employee<sup>C</sup>, and for the employee's general welfare<sup>D</sup>.
194. Population sizes<sup>A</sup>, at various times from the onset<sup>B</sup> of the agricultural revolution until census data first was kept in the 17<sup>th</sup> century<sup>C</sup>, have also been estimated.<sup>D</sup>
195. In fact, a few industries have already taken the initiative in cleaning up<sup>A</sup> their effluents, and some of these<sup>B</sup> have found it is possible<sup>C</sup> to make a profit from pollution by-products<sup>D</sup>.
196. Automobile advertising should emphasize economy<sup>A</sup> of purchase and operation, especially low mileage<sup>B</sup>, duration<sup>C</sup>, compactness<sup>D</sup>, comfort, engine efficiency, and low pollution emissions.
197. Protein malnutrition is usually most severe in young children, whose protein needs are greater than of adults<sup>A</sup> in proportion to body weight<sup>B</sup>, but who are, through<sup>C</sup> their parents' poverty, ignorance, or custom, often given<sup>D</sup> quite restricted diets.

It is unfortunately<sup>A</sup>, that at the time of the greatest crisis in the US the world<sup>B</sup> has ever faced, many Americans, especially the young, have given up the hope that the government can be modernized and changed in the direction through<sup>C</sup> the functioning of the elective process<sup>D</sup>.

199. Iodine is an essential component of thyroid hormones, which regulate growth<sup>A</sup> development, and metabolic activities; it is found in foods<sup>B</sup> grown in rich iodine<sup>C</sup> soil and in iodized<sup>D</sup> salt.
200. There is<sup>A</sup> reason to believe that population growth increases the probability of a lethal worldwide plague and of a thermonuclear war; any could provide an undesirable<sup>B</sup> "death rate solution" to the population problem<sup>C</sup>.
